And this year, we have had a strong response from out of town and even out of state attendees, with people flying in from states as far as Illinois, New Jersey, and even Canada! The Foundation is proud to host Keith Urban as the gala entertainer. Just some of his many accolades include four Grammy Awards, 10 Country Music Association Awards, 11 Academy of Country Music Awards, a People's Choice Award, and an American Music Award.

Urban is more than a world-renowned country music star. He is also a philanthropist, supporting dozens of charities. His "All For The Hall" benefit concerts for the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum©

have raised over \$2.6 million. He is the first Ambassador of the CMA Foundation, is an advisory board member at the St. Jude's Children's Hospital and is a longtime supporter of The Mr. Holland's Opus Fund and The Grammy Foundation. In 2013, he introduced his new URBAN™ Guitar Collection via HSN, proceeds of which benefit both the Grammy Foundation and Mr. Holland's Opus Fund.

A Loving, Lasting Tribute


The Tree of Life Project is an opportunity for family and friends to express their respect, compassion and love for those with cancer. This unique memorial also gives patients and families the opportunity to express their gratitude for their physicians. In addition, groups, organizations or individuals may also contribute to honor, highlight, commemorate, or memorialize those events or people who have been a significant part of their lives. Gifts to the tree of life will represent a lasting tribute for a special person or a meaningful event.

Local resident Pat Klein, in an effort to memorialize her dad and brother, who both passed away of cancer within a few years of one another, decided on the Tree of Life Project as a means of raising funds for necessary cancer equipment. Pat, along with her late husband Gerald Klein, donated the sculpture. Pat has a strong connection with CHRISTUS; she volunteered with CHRISTUS for over 10 years, and she also serves on the CHRISTUS Advisory Board. "I think it's such a great thing for people to see their loved one's names. I wanted to help others honor their family and friends," said Pat.

The Tree of Life is an original bronze sculpture by artist Sanford Werfel of New Jersey. The leaves, apples and the donor stones found at the base of the tree can be engraved with whatever sentiments donors wish to express.

The birth of a baby is a milestone. To capture this milestone, CHRISTUS Southeast Texas Foundation has created a one of a kind tribute, the Baby Honor Wall, in the Center for New Life at CHRISTUS Hospital — St. Elizabeth. The wall gives you a very special way to honor your little one.

With a tax deductible gift of \$500, \$1,000, or \$1,500, your child's name and date of birth will be inscribed into a tile on the Baby Honor Wall. Honoring a child is a wonderful way to help others. Your tax deductible donation for the tile will be utilized to support vital updates in the Center for New Life.

Dedicated on November 24th, 2014, the Baby Honor Wall is a one of a kind art installation made of red, blue and green tiles of graduated sizes in calming, translucent shades. To honor a baby, the child's name and date of birth will be permanently engraved into an individually created tile. The tiles are prominently placed across from the elevator so that all patients and visitors alike may see them upon entering and exiting the Center for New Life.
